INSPIRE Awards – MANAK

The *Innovation in Science Pursuit for Inspired Research (INSPIRE)* scheme is one of the flagship programmes of the Department of Science & Technology (DST), Government of India. The INSPIRE Awards–MANAK, implemented by DST through the National Innovation Foundation–India (NIF), aims to motivate students in the age group of 10–15 years (Classes VI to X) to pursue original ideas and innovations rooted in science and societal applications.

The objective of the scheme is to identify and nurture one million original student ideas, thereby fostering creativity, critical thinking, and innovative aptitude among school children. Schools may nominate students' best original ideas/innovations through the official portal up to 31st August 2026.

2. School Enterprise Challenge 2026–27

The School Enterprise Challenge provides an opportunity for students to develop an entrepreneurial mindset by setting up and managing a school-based enterprise. Through this national-level programme, students gain hands-on experience in market research, financial literacy, budgeting, and business planning, while also developing essential life skills such as communication, teamwork, leadership, and problem-solving. Profits generated may be utilized for school development, community welfare, or social causes.

3. Innovation club online connect: Students of innovation club connect online with experts and share their respective ideas about innovative projects, the experts and the mentor from Bharti Foundation works with the students to transform the best ideas into physical projects.
